

SWISS base

Context: High quality and well-documented datasets, as well as their long-term preservation and accessibility are basic requirements for open data and also its key challenges. Most of the universities in Switzerland do not have the necessary expertise and technical solutions to fulfill these requirements.

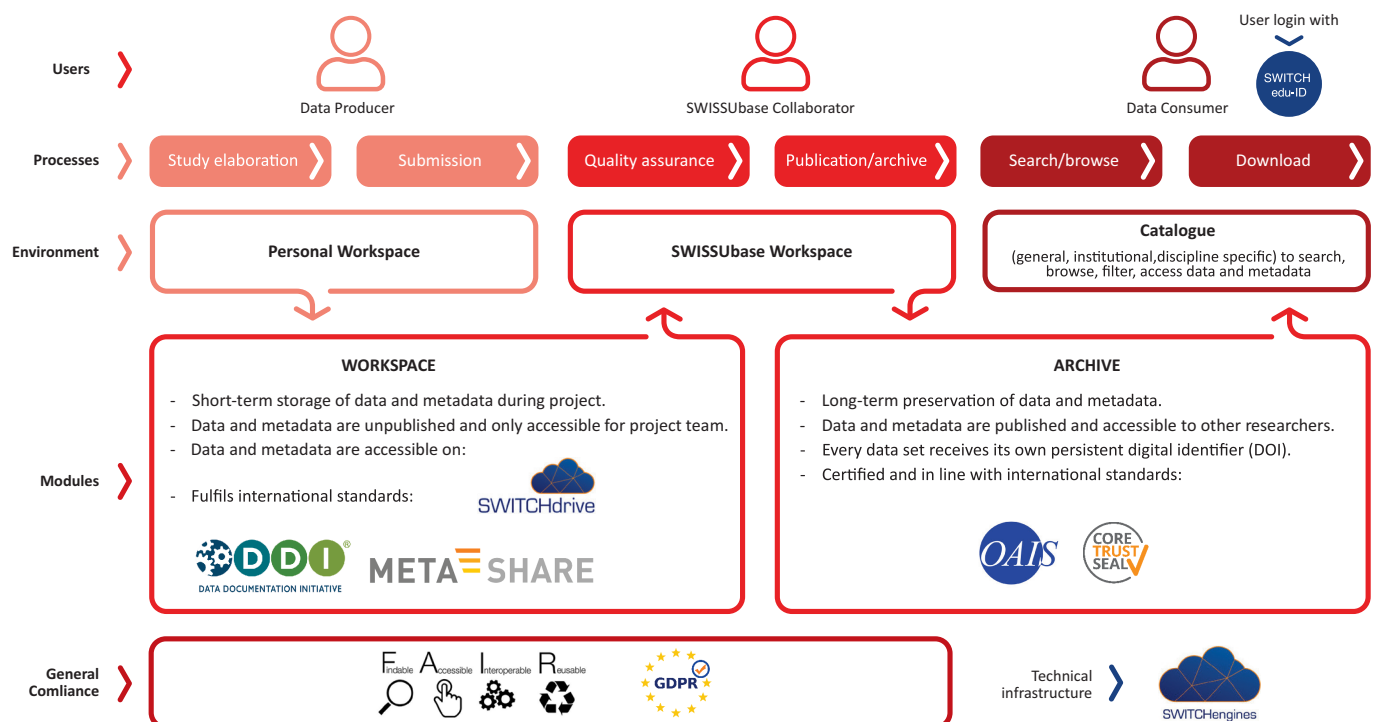
Objective: Further develop the functionalities of the established social science archive FORSbase and, as a result, offer the national infrastructure SWISSUbase for the long-term preservation and sharing of scientific research data across all scientific disciplines.

What it is: SWISSUbase offers to Swiss universities and other research institutions a research data management service to archive, share and promote data and project metadata. Fully compliant with international standards, the modular structure of SWISSUbase is at the same time flexible enough to provide tailored responses to the needs of different institutional policies and scientific disciplines.
